Which proposed amendment was adopted and
The bill was read the second time.

Mr. Bouic, from Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported with recommendation that said bill be referred to the Committee on Finance.

Senate bill No. 147, entitled “An Act to repeal section 1, Article 24, of the Code of Public General Laws, title ‘Costs,’ and to re-enact the same with amendments.”

Which was referred to the Committee on Finance.

Mr. Bouic, from Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported favorably, with proposed amendment,

House bill entitled “An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 179, of Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled ‘Prince George’s County,’ sub-title ‘Jurors’ as amended by the Acts of 1898, chapter 433.”

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend by striking out all after the word “court,” at the beginning of the third line from the end of the bill.

Which proposed amendment was adopted, and
The bill was read the second time.

House bill entitled “An Act to repeal section 4, of Article 66, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title ‘Mortgages,’ and to re-enact the same with amendments.”

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend by adding at the end of section 1, after the word “purchased” the following: “Provided, however, that nothing in this Act shall be held or construed to effect existing rights.”

Which proposed amendment was adopted, and
The bill was read the second time.
