Mr. Peter, from Select Committee, reported favorably, Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 279, of Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Prince George's County,' sub-title 'Sheriff,' and to re-enact the same with amendments.'"

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Dodson, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the commissioners of St. Michaels to borrow money on the credit of said town for the purpose of constructing water works and electric lights for said town, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said town, to redeem said bonds and pay the interest thereon."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Rohrback, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to empower the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick county, Maryland, to provide for free scholarships to students of Frederick county in the Buckeystown Normal School, in said county."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also, unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Governor of Maryland to appoint a notary public for the town of Myersville, in Frederick county, Maryland."

Which report was adopted.
