pointment of a board of visitors for Anne Arundel county jail, and defining the powers and duties of said board."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add new sections to Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Anne Arundel County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners,' to be designated 'Sections 126 B, 126 C and 126 D,' authorizing the county commissioners to have witnesses summoned to testify before them.'"
