House bill entitled "An Act to make valid the sales made and the deeds, devises and other instrument of writing executed and delivered by trustee or trustees to whom any estate, real, personal or mixed, shall have been limited or conveyed for the benefit of creditors, or to be sold for any other purpose, when such trustee or trustees have failed to comply with the requirements of section 205, of Article 16, of the Maryland Code of Public General Laws in giving bond with but one surety."
