INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendment, sections 1 and 2, of Article 59, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Lunatics and Insane," subtitle "Lunatics or Insane Paupers."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

By Mr. Moses, (by request,)

A bill entitled an Act to amend an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1898, Chapter 259, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Real Estate Trust Company so that the corporate title of the said corporation shall hereafter be Colonial Trust Company."

A bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 9A, of chapter 381, of the Acts of Assembly, passed January Session, 1888, entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington county."
