'County Commissioners,' providing for the publication of assets and liabilities in their annual statement as required by section 11, Article 25, of the Public General Laws of Maryland."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Hubner, Williams of Anne Arundel and Williams of Harford.

The Secretary of State appeared and delivered a message from the Executive.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and delivered the following message:
