And said bill was recommitted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

On motion of Mr. Bouic,

The Senate reconsidered its action in adopting the unfavorable report by the Committee on Judicial Proceedings upon

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize Archie C. Holloway, of Worcester county, to settle his accounts as guardian to John L. Holloway, and to pay over all moneys due said ward."

And said bill was recommitted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

President Hubner, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Baltimore Country Club of Baltimore city to take out a license to sell liquors to its members under the provisions of the Act of Assembly of 1890, chapter 334."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Moses, from Select Committee, reported with recommendation that said bill be referred to the Committee on Temperance,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 4, entitled 'City of Baltimore,' of the Code of Public Local I aws of Maryland, as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 123, of the Acts of 1898, to follow section 682, and to be designated as 'Section 682 A.'"

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Temperance.

Mr. Bouic, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to preserve the streets and protect the property rights of citizens of incorporated towns of Montgomery county."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
