In section 1 strike out "jail," in the 9th line of original bill, and insert the "House of Correction."

Strike out the word "and" after the word "jail" on line 9 of original bill, and insert the word "or."

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 21, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Conveyancing,' to follow section 58, and be designated as 'Section 85 A."
