House bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 109, of Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Hyattstown,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Bouie, Applegarth and Gray.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 32, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Collectors and Collections,' so far as the same relates to Montgomery county, and to add a new section to be known as 'Section 226,' to Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Taxes.'"
