AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In line 17 of the engrossed bill after the word "give," insert the words "such bribe present or reward or such promise or security and the person receiving the same."

At the end of section 1 of line 22 of engrossed bill, add the words "provided that any person receiving any such bribe, present or reward or such promise or security compelled to testify in any for any of the acts referred to in this section shall be exempted from trial and punishment for any such acts, including the disqualification hereinbefore mentioned."

In section 2 of engrossed bill, line 3, after the word "election," insert the words "for members of the General Assembly."
