

Mr. Bouic, from Select Committee, reported favorably, House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 109, of Article 10, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Hyattstown,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Applegarth, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester county to borrow money upon the credit of the county for the purpose of constructing a bridge across the northwest fork of the Nanticoke river, in said county, at a point called 'Harrison's Ferry,' and placing a draw therein, to give their bonds or bills obligatory for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county, to redeem said bonds or bills obligatory, and to pay the interest thereon."

Which was read the second time.

Also favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 25 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'County Commissioners,' sub-title 'Draining Land,' in so far as the same applies to Dorchester county, to follow after section 49, and to be numbered '49 A.'"
