The institution is not only a necessity but find that it is also a paying one, as their report shows that they turned over to the State Treasurer \$33,000 last year.

The appropriation asked for is \$2,000,000, and your committee, personally favor this amount asked for as we think it will be the means of a further increase in their balance which they have turned into the State Treasury.

Your committee regret that they were unable to visit all of the public buildings in which the people of Maryland are interested, but if those not visited are in a condition such as those we have visited, the State is to be heartily congratulated.

Your committee also suggest and recommend an Auditor to audit the books of the public institutions of this State that receive State appropriations.
