Senate bill No. 240, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'General Regulations,' to follow immediately after section 85 L, and to be designated as 'Section 85 M,' to permit life and accident insurance companies and safe deposit, trust, guaranty, loan and fidelity companies, now or hereafter doing business in this State, to deposit with the Treasurer of this State, as the security required by law, first mortgage bonds of electric railway companies operating within this State, when said bonds have been respectively approved by the Board of Public Works."
