Senate bill No. 202, entitled "An Act to incorporate the United Real Estate Company of Baltimore."

Which report was adopted.

Senate reconsidered its action by which the said unfavorable report was adopted, and

Said bill was recommitted to the Committee on Corporations.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 769, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Street Railway Fares, as amended and re-enacted by chapter 123, of the Acts of 1898'"

Which was read the second time.

Also without recommendation,

Senate bill No. 235, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Union Automobile Company."
