Senate bill entitled "An Act to add additional sections to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 123, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session 1898, sub-title 'Miscellaneous Local Laws,' sub-title Police Commissions,' sub-title 'Special Fund,' to follow section 776, and to be known as 'Sections 776 A, 776 B, 776 C, 776 D, 776 E and 776 F.'"
