

Senate bill No. 231, entitled "An Act to authorize the change of name of the Washington and Rockville Railway Company of Montgomery county, a corporation formed under the provisions of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, and to authorize the consolidation of said company with certain other corporations incorporated for the same or similar purposes, and to grant additional powers to the said railway company."
