Senate bill No. 194, entitled "An Act to repeal sections 196 to 209, inclusive, of Article 1, of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Allegany County,' sub-title 'Mine Inspector,' and also to repeal sections 150 to 164, inclusive, of Article 12, of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Garrett County,' sub-title 'Manufactures and Mines,' as amended by chapter 34, of the Acts of 1898, providing for the appointment of mine inspectors for Allegany and Garrett counties, and regulating the working and proper ventilation for coal mines in said counties, and to re-enact them with amendments, and to add certain new sections to said respective Articles to follow in the first mentioned Article, section 209, to be designated as 'Sections 209 A, 209 B, 209 C and 209 D,' and to follow in the second mentioned Article, section 164, to be designated as 'Sections 164 A, 164 B and 164 C.'"
