House bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the Eureka Mutual Aid Society of Baltimore city, a corporation duly incorporated under the General Laws of this State."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to change the name of the Mortgage and Trust Company, incorporated by chapter 263, of the Acts of 1898, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the Mortgage and Trust Company to that of the Standard Trust Company,' and to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 13, of said chapter, subjecting said company to certain provisions and authorizing it to unite with other like companies.'"

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Inspectors, Weights and Measures,' sub-division 'Coal,' to follow section 539, and to be known as 'Section 539 A.'"

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Bryan, Moses and Putzel.

House bill entitled "An Act to refund to John J. Scoon and 28 others, citizens of Kent county and State of Maryland, the sum of \$5 each, paid to the State of Maryland in error, as recorded by the Circuit Court for Kent county, Md., as a tax under chapter 441 of the Acts of 1896, as per license certificates hereto attached."
