Senate bill entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland, to the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Wm. R. Acton, late of Charles county, deceased, of one hundred dollars to and for the use and benefit of Port Tobacco Parish, under the name of 'Vestry of St. Paul's Church.'"

Also, unfavorably,

Senate bill No. 235, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Union Automobile Company."
