Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to confirm and enlarge the powers and authority of the 'Municipal Art Society of Baltimore City,' a corporation duly incorporated under the provisions of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland."

Which was read the second time.

Also favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Liberty and Pike Creek Turnpike Road Company, a body corporate, to issue bonds to take the place of certain bonds now outstanding."

Which was read the second time.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 3, 5, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of chapter 514 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed in the year 1898, entitled an Act to incorporate the Frederick, Thurmont and Northern Railway Company, and re-enact the same with amendments, conferring enlarged and additional powers, and to change the name of said company to the Washington, Frederick and Gettysburg Railway Company."

Which was read the second time.

Also, favorably, with proposed amendment,

House bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the Eureka Mutual Aid Society of Baltimore city, a corporation duly incorporated under the General Laws of this State."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

After section 4 add the following: "Provided that said corporation shall be subject at all times to the provisions of the Acts of 1892, chapters 109 and 279, or amendments or supplements thereto."

Which proposed amendment was adopted, and

The bill was read the second time.
