Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of St. Mary's county, to pay to the Town Commissioners of Donaldtown, the money levied in said town for road tax."

Mr. Putzel, from Select Committee, reported favorably with proposed amendment,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections 43 and 51 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1898, chapter 123, being Article 4 of the Code of Public Laws, title 'Baltimore City,' sub-title 'Charter relating to Collection of Taxes.'"

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend on line 34 of the bill by substituting the word "them" for the word "four."
