Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to add two additional sections to Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'Insurance Department,' to be known as 'Section 126 A and Section 126 B,' of said Act, said additional sections being intended to prevent the payment of commissions to unlicensed agents or solicitors."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the clerk of the Circuit Court from Talbot county from issuing license to any person or company of circus riders, equestrian performers or to any person or company to exhibit for reward any animal or animals or natural or artificial curiosities (except models for useful inventions) during the months of August, September and October, (except to fair associations or persons authorized by them) and providing for such unlicensed exhibitions."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Dodson, Messick and Applegarth.

Also returned,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Miscellaneous Local Laws,' said section to follow immediately after section 623, and to be designated 'Section 623 A.'"

Endorsed: "Unfavorably reported by Select Committee, and report adopted."
