

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize the town of Takoma Park, to borrow an additional sum of money not exceeding \$10,000 with credit of said town (if the same shall be necessary for the purpose of constructing and maintaining waterworks and a sewerage system for said town), to issue bonds for the payment thereof, and to levy taxes to redeem said bonds, and to pay the interest thereon, to authorize the issue of said bonds and also a prior issue of bonds for the purpose of constructing and maintaining waterworks and a sewerage system only."
