

and also to redeem the one hundred and twenty-three thousand and seven hundred dollars of bonds, bearing interest at four per centum per annum, issued by said county commissioners under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the session of 1886, chapter 239, both of which issues of bonds are now redeemable and may be paid by said county commissioners and to authorize and empower the said county commissioners to levy and collect the necessary taxes for the payment of the bonds authorized to be issued and the interest thereon."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 4, line 2, strike out the word "State."

BILLS—THIRD READING.
