REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES.

Mr. Crothers, from Committee on Finance, reported favorably,

Senate bill No. 58, entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the treasurer of the State Board of Education the amount of sundry bills paid by him for repairs to the State Normal School building."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to establish a commission of State Aid and Charities."

Which was read the second time.

Also favorably, with proposed amendments,

Senate bill No. 161, entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact with amendments, section 87, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Payment of Taxes by Corporations,' and also to add two new sections to said Article, the first under the sub-title 'Valuation and Assessment,' to follow section 2, and to be known as 'Section 2 A,' and the second under the sub-title 'Appeals,' to follow section 18 B, and to be known as 'Section 18 C.'"
