"And be it enacted, That it shall be unlawful to hunt for foxes or pursue them with dog between March 10th and November 1st in each and every year. Any person violating this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine of not less than \$5 and not more than \$25 for each and every offense."
