SEC. 4. Be it enacted, That if the tax collector shall neglect For neglect to to report as required by the aforegoing section he may be called before the Mayor and Councilmen and by them fined the sum of ten dollars, which fine may be deducted from his salary or collected as other fines are.

Be it enacted, That before the tax collector shall enter upon his duties he shall take and subscribe to the following oath, before the Mayor, I——having been elected tax collector by the Mayor and Councilmen of the town of Frostburg, in the presence of Almighty God, do solemnly promise and declare that I will faithfully perform the duty of tax collector and will collect all taxes, water rents and assessments according to law without fear, favor, or partiality.

## CHAPTER 640.
