D., 1887, and codicil thereto, of one thousand dollars each to the formed Presby-Seminary at Pittsburg, Pennsylvania, which is under the charge and control of the Synod of the Reformed Presbyterian Church of North America, and to the Boards of Foreign and Home Missions of said church, and also a bequest of one hundred dollars to the congregation established in Baltimore, Maryland, of the said church, and to the addition of four hundred dollars to said last bequest added by the codicil to the last will and testament of Eliza Anne Coulter, and to the bequests made by and contained in the last will and testament of Eliza Jane Coulter, late of Baltimore County, deceased, dated 5th of October, 1894, of like amounts to said objects, and ratifying and confirming the bequests made by the said John Coulter in his will and codicil to the will of said Eliza Jane Coulter, adding the sum of four hundred dollars to the bequest to the congregation established in Baltimore, Maryland, of said church, as aforesaid.
