Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-Miscellaneous land, That a new section, to be designated as Section 321A, to come in after Section three hundred and twenty-one of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, as repealed and re-enacted by the Act of eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, Chapter 123, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Miscellaneous Local Laws," be and the same is hereby added to said Article so as to read as follows:

CHAPTER 706.

AN ACT to empower the County Commissioners of Prince George's County to sell a School House in election district No. 14 of said county.

Prince George's Co, Authority to sell school house, etc.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Prince George's County are hereby authorized and empowered to sell white School House No. 2, in election district No. 14, and from the proceeds of such sale, and with additional appropriation of three hundred and fifty dollars by said Commissioners, to purchase a lot and erect a new school house on the public
