

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the Mayor and Council shall cause to be kept a careful register of the bonds so issued, and the transfer thereof, and as the same are called in and paid off they shall be cancelled, and a record of the cancellations by numbers, amounts and names of the last holders of said bonds shall be made and entered upon the books in which said bonds are registered; provided, however, that at an election to be held on the fourth Monday in March, nineteen hundred, the creation of the debt herein provided for shall be submitted to the qualified voters of Hagerstown, who shall cast their ballot marked, printed or written, "For Series Three of Drainage Bonds" or "Against Series Three of Drainage Bonds," respectively, as such voters shall desire to vote in favor of or against said loan; and if a majority of the votes so cast shall be "For Series Three of Drainage Bonds," then Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of this Act shall be in effect; and if a majority of the votes so cast shall be "Against Series Three of Drainage Bonds," the said sections herein designated shall be null and void; and the Mayor shall give five days' notice that the matters provided for in this Act will be submitted to the voters of Hagerstown, by publication in at least two newspapers of said town five days before the day of said election.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 120.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter two hundred and thirty-one of the Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, entitled an "Act to confer on the Chesapeake Beach Railway Company the powers, rights and franchises granted to the Washington & Chesapeake Beach Railway Company, by Chapter two hundred and forty-five of the Acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Town of Chesapeake Beach, in Calvert County," and to re-enact said Chapter two hundred and forty-five of the Acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Chapter two hundred and thirty-one of the Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, entitled an "Act to confer upon the Chesapeake Beach Railway Company the powers,
