CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a certain gift and bequest to the "Redemptorists," a body corporate.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Marysanctioned. land, That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby declared given and granted to the gift and bequest of two thousand dollars to the Redemptorists, a body corporate, contained in the will of Clara Rerny, said will being dated November first, eighteen hundred and ninetynine, and being duly filed in the Orphans' Court for Baltimore City.

> SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 9A, of Chapter three hundred and eighty-one, of the Acts of Assembly passed January Session, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, entitled "An Act to amend the Charter of the Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-Agricultural land, That Section 9A, of Chapter three hundred and eightyand Mechanical one, of the Acts of Assembly passed at the January Session, Association of eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, entitled "An Act to amend washington" the Charter of the Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Sec. 9A. And said Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington County may hold exhibitions on its from payment grounds as often as it may deem necessary without the payment of licenses, of any license fine for forfaiture or regular to the State of any license, fine, fee, forfeiture or penalty to the State of Maryland, to Washington County, or to the Corporation of Hagerstown, and any person or persons, association or organized company, to whom said Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington County shall grant the privilege to sell, barter, show, exhibit, or in any way conduct any business on the grounds of said Agricultural and Mechanical
