Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-St. Mary's Co. land, That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County to copy be and he is hereby authorized and directed to copy in a wellall marriage bound book, to be furnished for that purpose by the County certificates from and to a Commissioners, all marriage certificates and records of marriage, now of record in said office from A. D. 1794 to A. D. 1864, both inclusive; the said record to be arranged according to date and in alphabetical order, the amount thereof to be levied and paid by the County Commissioners of said county; Cost of. provided, that the cost of said work shall not exceed the sum of fifty dollars.

> SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 376.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section two of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "Almshouse."

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-St. Mary's Co. Almshouse. land, That Section two of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "Almshouse," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, so as to read as follows:

2. The County Commissioners may annually at their first Maintenance regular meeting in June, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and support of paupers and let said almshouse and other property to such person as they cost. may deem fit, and the said Commissioners may, in their discretion, provide for the maintenance and support of such paupers as may be inmates of said almshouse, or those who thereafter may be committed thereto, at a cost not exceeding seventy-five dollars each per annum.

> SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
