CHAPTER 443.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland, in their discretion, to construct a Bridge across Narrows Ferry.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Dorchester County be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to construct a bridge across Narrows Ferry, in Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland.

Dorchester Co. Commissioners authorized to construct bridge.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said County Commissioners of Dorchester County be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to issue bonds to an amount necessary to pay the cost of erecting said bridge.

May issue bonds.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 444.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter five hundred and fifty-six of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, entitled an Act to prohibit the shooting of wild water fowl from sink-boxes or sneak boats, or from any other boat or craft on the Elk and Bohemia Rivers, in Cecil County, and to repeal Sections three hundred and sixty-one to three hundred and seventy, inclusive, of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "Wild Fowl."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Chapter five hundred and fifty-six of the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, entitled an Act to prohibit the shooting of wild water fowl from sink-boxes or sneak boats, or from any other boat or craft, on the waters of the Elk and Bohemia Rivers, in Cecil County, and to repeal sections three hundred
