

voter in the precinct of the——ward of the city——(or district, county) in the said State; that I will support the Constitution of the United States, and that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to the State of Maryland, and support the Constitution and laws thereof, and that I will faithfully and honestly discharge the duties of an officer of registration and judge of election (or clerk of election) for the precinct of the——ward of the city of——(or district) of——county in the State of Maryland, according to the best of my ability; and I do further swear (or affirm) that I will not attempt to ascertain, save in cases and in the manner in which I am authorized by law so to do, for what candidate or candidates any person shall vote or has voted on any question which may be or may have been submitted to the vote of the people; and if such knowledge shall be acquired by me, I will not directly or indirectly by word or act divulge or reveal the same, or aid in doing so, save when I may be required to do so by law in some legal proceeding.

#### CHAPTER 465.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Montgomery County to levy a sum of money to refund to the Gaithersburg Milling and Manufacturing Company of Montgomery County certain sums of money erroneously paid by the said company to said County Commissioners for taxes for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-four, eighteen hundred and ninety-five and eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Montgomery County be and they are hereby authorized to levy for the use of the Gaithersburg Milling and Manufacturing Company of Montgomery County the sum of eight hundred and eighty-one dollars and fifty cents, the amount of county taxes erroneously paid by said company to said Commissioners for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-four, eighteen hundred and ninety-five and eighteen hundred and ninety-six; provided, that the levying of said sum of money shall be by a unanimous vote of said Board of County Commissioners.
