

Issue of bonds submitted to voters of said town.

SEC. 7. That at the election to be held in the town of Kensington, in Montgomery County, Maryland, in the year 1900, the question whether or not said town shall issue bonds to an amount not exceeding twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the purpose of providing a proper water supply for said town, shall be and is hereby directed to be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of said town; in order to advise the citizens of said town of the intent of this Act it shall be the duty of the Mayor and City Council to publish in some newspaper of general circulation in said town the substance of this Act for two weeks previous to said election, and to give such other notice as they may deem necessary and proper; that at said election the ballots shall have printed on them the words "For the issue of water bonds" and "Against the issue of water bonds;" if three-fifths of the ballots cast shall contain the words "For the issue of water bonds," then this Act shall become operative and binding; but if over two-fifths of said ballots shall contain the words "Against the issue of water bonds," then this Act shall be void and of no effect; and the judges of said municipal election, or a majority of them, shall return to the Mayor of said town the number of ballots cast "For the issue of water bonds" and "Against the issue of water bonds," respectively, and the Mayor shall publicly announce the result thereof.

CHAPTER 467.

Wicomico Co. AN ACT to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the Sharptown Marine Railway Company of Sharptown, Wicomico County, Maryland, a corporation duly incorporated under the General Laws of this State.

Sharptown Marine Railway Company, etc.

WHEREAS, The Sharptown Marine Railway Company, of Sharptown, Wicomico County, Maryland, was duly incorporated on the 13th day of April, 1899, under the provisions of the General Laws of this State relating to the creation and regulation of incorporated companies in the State of Maryland, certificate of which incorporation is recorded amongst the Corporation Records of Wicomico County in Liber J. V. T., No. 1, Folio 144, and is desirous of extending the privileges and enlarging the powers of the said corporation; and
