Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That every turnpike company or other toll road in this companies, State shall cause a bright light to reflect upon their toll bars Light to reflect or gates when down during the hours of darkness, and upon upon gates and bars when indictment and conviction for any violation of the provisions of this Act, such company or companies shall be fined not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 547.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester County to borrow money on the credit of the county for the purpose of constructing a bridge across the northwest fork of the Nanticoke River, in said county, at a point called Harrison Ferry, and placing a draw therein, to give their bond or bills obligatory for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem said bonds or bills obligatory and to pay the interest thereon.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Dorchester County Commission'rs be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their authorized to discretion, to contract for the construction of a bridge across construction the northwest fork of the Nanticoke River, in said county, at a point called Harrison Ferry, and the placing of a draw therein, so as to provide better facilities for navigation, as well as for the safety and convenience of the public in passing over said bridge; and for the purpose of paying for said bridge, the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized to borrow borrow certain on the credit of said county such sum or sums of money as sum of money may be necessary not exceeding in all the sum of two thousand give bond, may be necessary, not exceeding in all the sum of two thousand dollars, and to give their bond or bills obligatory therefor in sums of not more than one thousand dollars each, to be signed by the president of the board of said Commissioners, and to be countersigned by the County Treasurer of said county, and to have the corporation seal of said Commissioners affixed thereto, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of January and July, in each and every year.
