SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section fifty-nine of Article 11 of the Code of Birds and Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Birds and Game," as enacted by Chapter three hundred and nine of the Acts of eighteen hundred and ninety, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

game.

59. It shall not be lawful for any person to shoot or trap gray or fox squirrels between the first day of November and shoot or trap the fifteenth day of June in each and every year, and if any within certain person shall be found guilty by any justice of the peace of said county he shall be adjudged to pay a fine of not more than five dollars for each and every squirrel so killed or trapped for the first offense, and upon failure or refusal of the party to pay said fine, he shall be committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding ten days; and for each and every offense after the first, such party shall be subject to a fine of not less than five dollars and not more than ten dollars for each squirrel so killed or trapped, and upon failure or refusal to pay said fine he shall be committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding twenty days. The right to appeal to the Circuit Court, however, shall not be denied to any person adjudged guilty.

Penalty.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

W. M., No. 75, folio 87, etc.
