CHAPTER 572.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of intoxicating liquors at Ruxton Station, Baltimore County, Maryland, or within a radius of a mile thereof.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall not be lawful to sell spirituous or intoxicating liquors at Ruxton Station, Northern Central Railroad, Baltimore County, Maryland, or within a radius of one mile of the said Station.

Station. Unlawful to sell liquors.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That any person or persons or corporation who may violate the provisions of this Act shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than five hundred dollars, or imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty days nor more than one year, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

Penalty for violation.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 573.

AN ACT to require the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County to levy the sum of five hundred dollars to reimburse the Board of School Commissioners of Calvert County for money expended in building a school-house at Solomon's Island.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Calvert County be and they are hereby authorized and required to levy the sum commission'rs of Calvert Co. of five hundred dollars upon the assessable property of Cal-Refund a sum vert County at the next levy to reimburse the Board of School of money to Board of Commissioners for money expended in erecting and furnishing School Commission'rs a school-house at Solomon's Island, in Calvert County.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 574.

AN ACT authorizing and empowering the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County to appoint an additional constable for the seventh election district of said county.
