This section shall not apply to the cases of voluntary commitments as provided for in Section thirty-seven.

## CHAPTER 604.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of an additional justice of the peace in the fifth election district and in the seventh election district of Montgomery County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint an additional justice of the peace in and for the fifth election district of Montgomery County, and an additional justice of the peace for the seventh election district of Montgomery County, who shall be appointed from and reside in the settlement in said election district known as Chevy Chase.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
