SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That if the purposes contemplated by this Act should not demand an immediate sale of bonds from all the bonds provided for by said Act, the said Governor, time to time, as required. Comptroller of the Treasury and Treasurer, or a majority of them, may issue advertisements from time to time, in accordance with the provisions of this Act, for such part or parts of said loan as may from time to time be required.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the sum of two thousand Appropriation dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby bonds, etc. appropriated for the payment of the expenses of engraving, printing and other expenses connected with the issue of the loan authorized by this Act, and for the payment of advertising authorized by this Act, and of all incidental expenses connected with the execution of the provisions of this Act.

SEC. 7. CHAPTER 608.

AN ACT supplemental to Chapter two hundred and nineteen of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and fifty-six, entitled an Act for founding a College at Chestertown.
