And be it further enacted, That the ten days' notice Publish notice shall be given by publication in one or more newspapers published in Baltimore City of the time and place of said annual election, which annual election shall be conducted by three stockholders to be selected by the body of stockholders, one of whom shall be designated to act as judge, and the other two as inspectors.

SEC. 16. And be it further enacted, That the directors shall have power to declare such dividends of profits of the said corporation as they may deem proper; provided, that no dividend shall be declared, when the capital stock would be impaired thereby.

SEC. 17. And be it enacted, That the said company shall solidate, make have power to make insurance of any kind, and to execute and perfect all such instruments of writing as may be required therefor, and shall also have power to consolidate with any other company or corporation having like or similar powers, upon such terms as may be agreed upon by the majority of the stockholders of such company or corporation.

> SEC. 17A. Provided, that said corporation shall be subject at all times to the provisions of the Acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-two, Chapter 109 and 279, or amendments or supplements thereto.

> SEC. 18. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
