and that it shall and may be lawful for the faid president and directors, after the faid canal shall be made navigable, to demand and receive the following tolls at fach place or places in the canal as they may hereafter direct, provided that the whole toll received thall not amount to more than the rates fixed by this act; that is to fay, Every pipe of wine or French brandy containing more than one hundred and twenty gallons, 1 25 Every hoghead of rum, or other spirits, . 0 Every hogshead of tobacco, 75 Every hogshead of beer, cyder, rice or molasses, And all other casks or kegs in proportion according to the quantity and quality of their con-For casks of linfeed oil, fame as spirits. 4 Every bushel of wheat, peas, beans or flax-feed, 2 Every bushel of Indian corn, or other grain or falt, 30 Every barrel of pork, beef or fish, 20 Every barrel of flour, |. 0 Every ton of hemp, flax, potash, bar or manusactured iron, 0 Every ton of pig-iron or castings, Q Every ton of copper, lead, or other ore, other than iron ore, 50 Every ton of stone or iron ore, 37 Every chalron of coals, 10 Every hundred pipe or hogshead staves, or pipe or hogshead heading, 6 Every hundred barrel staves or barrel heading, 75 Every thousand shingles, two feet long or more, 50. Every thousand shingles less than two feet long, 75 Every hundred cubic feet of plank or fcantling, 40 Every hundred cubic feet of other timber, 10 Every gross hundred weight of all other commodities or packages,

And for all other commodities, the fame proportion, agreeable to the articles herein enume-And every boat or vessel which has not commodities on board to pay the sum of four dollars, shall pay so much, as, with the commodities on board, will yield the sum aforesaid. And every empty boat or veffel, four dollars, except an empty boat or veffel returning,

whose load has already paid the tolls affixed, in which case she shall repass toll free; provided fuch boat or vessel shall return within sourteen days after paying said tolls,

On refufal to pay, veffels may be reivied paifage, &c.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in case of refusal or neglect to pay the toll at the time of offering to pass through the said canal, and previous to the vessel's passing through the same, the collectors of the said tolls may lawfully refuse passage to such vessel; and if any vessel shall pass without paying the faid toll, then the faid collectors may feize fuch vessel wherever found, and fell the same at auction for ready money, which, fo far as is necessary, shall be applied towards paying said toll, and all expences of feizure and fale, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner, and the person having the direction of fuch veffel shall be liable for fuch toll, if the same is not paid by the sale of fuch vellel as aforefaid; provided that the faid proprietors, or a majority of them, holding at least five hundred shares, shall have full power and authority, at any general meeting, to lessen the said tolls, or any of them; provided also, that the same rate of tolls shall be paid on articles passing from Chesapeake to Delaware as upon those paid from Delaware to Chesapeake.

XI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid canal, and the works to be erected thereon in virtue of this act, when completed, shall for ever thereafter be esteemed and taken to be navigable as a public highway, free for the transportation of all goods, commodities or produce whatsoever, on payment of the tells imposed by this act; and no toll or tax whatever for the use of the water of the said canal, and the works thereon erected, shall at any time hereafter be imposed by all or either of the said states.

XII. AND, whereas it is necessary for the making the said canal, and supplying the same with water, that providen should be made for condemning a quantity of land for these purposes, BE IT ENACTED. That it shall and may be lawful for the said president and directors, or a majority of them, to purchase, from the owners thereof, any land through which the faid canal is intended to pass, or through which it may be necessary to supply water to the same; and in case of disagreement, or in
