So the Convention refused to reconsider the vote.

Mr. Stockbridge moved to open the third section to further amendment;

Decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Stockbridge submitted the following amendment:

Section 3, line fourteen, strike out the words "seventy-nine," and insert the word "eighty;"

Decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Belt moved to open the third section of the report for further amendment;

Decided in the negative.

The report, as amended, was then read the third time, and gassed by yeas and nays as follows:
