

1 14. The question, however, is not free from doubt. The
2 Chair does not wish to be arbitrary and will therefore submit
3 the question of whether the amendment is in order to a vote
4 of the Committee of the Whole without debate.

5 The question therefore now arises whether
6 Amendment 23 be received. A vote Aye will be a vote in
7 favor of consideration of amendment 23. A vote No will be
8 a vote against consideration of Amendment 23, that is, that
9 it is out of order.

10 This is not a vote on either adoption or
11 rejection of the amendment, but merely whether further
12 debate shall be permitted. So that you may thoroughly
13 understand the question, I will ask the Clerk first to read
14 first Amendment 14, and then Amendment 23, but before doing
15 that I will ask the Clerk to ring the quorum bell.

16 The Clerk will read Amendment 14 and then
17 Amendment 23.
