

1 Amendment 23 is in order, that is, whether it be received.
2 A vote Aye is a vote that the amendment is in order, and
3 may be received for debate. A vote No is a vote that the
4 amendment is not in order.

5 Cast your votes. Has every Delegate voted?
6 Does any Delegate desire to change his vote?

7 Delegate James Clark, will you announce your
8 vote orally?

9 DELEGATE CLARK: No.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate James Clark votes No.
11 The Clerk will record the vote.

12 There being 46 votes Aye and 62 votes No, the
13 amendment is out of order.

14 I am in error. 46 votes in the affirmative, and
15 61 votes in the negative, and the amendment is out of order.

18 You will recall that this minority report was tendered in
19 connection with the committee recommendation R&P-1. At the
