3 however.

4 DELEGATE WILLIS: We spoke of institutions of
5 higher learning. Would you bring it down to local boards
6 of education and staff meetings, where county commissioners
7 have quarterly meetings of all the heads of their depart-
8 ments? I believe that is a little different.

9 DELEGATE WILLONER: I don't quite understand.

10 The purpose is to get at those decisions that
11 affect the public interest. If you are discussing
12 matters of -- you are having troubles with students at
13 school, obviously it is not intended to cover that kind of
14 thing.

15 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Pullen.

16 DELEGATE PULLEN: Mr. Chairman, I should like
17 to ask if this recommendations would apply to all institu-
18 tions subsidized in part with public money, federal, state
19 or local.
