4 that we add it to the Constitution.

9 DELEGATE KIEFER: I yield 3 minutes to Delegate
10 Winslow.

11 DELEGATE WINSLOW: Mr. Chairman, I rise in
12 opposition to this amendment as a part of the Constitution.
13 I am extremely reluctant to oppose the idea that we should
14 have admission to our public proceedings and our public
15 records.

16 However, I suggest that the amendment as drawn
17 is an extremely uncertain thing which has become very
18 clear in the question and answer period.

19 The amendment as drawn suggests that all
20 governmental proceedings, meetings and records shall be open
21 except as otherwise prescribed by public general law. This
