3 How much consideration was given to this
4 substitute? Is it the substitute of the committee which
5 considered the language, or is it an amendment as would
6 be presented by Delegate Kiefer, or any other delegate,
7 and which we would consider in that light?

8 DELEGATE KIEFER: I do not deny the pattern of
9 this. This is my idea, but I will say the concept of what
10 was to be in this -- the committee adopted the concept of
11 the right to know, but I don't remember that any specific
12 language was completely spelled out.

13 There was a lot of confusion about this, because
14 it was withdrawn by Delegate Hostetter, but there were
15 a number of efforts made to write something into our
16 recommendations, and this particular one, as a matter of
17 fact, was originally introduced to the committee by
18 Delegate Weidemeyer, so we had a great deal of thought and
19 a great deal of conversation and a great deal of debate
20 and there was not any particular set forth.
