

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Willoner.

2 DELEGATE WILLONER: In answer to the question,
3 I have to admit we had some difficulty with it because
4 when this was written, when it was not part of the law
5 of Maryland. My feeling would be that it would come
6 under an exception; that this would involve personnel
7 matters and salary matters, and therefore the provision
8 would open these up, but the legislature could cover it
9 as is in the suggested statute.

10 This would be an area in the personnel matter
11 that would be proper to close. In my opinion the
12 provision provides for it. In three years the
13 legislature would have a right to take care of the matter
14 and it would be covered in the proposed statute we have
15 given for consideration.
