

1 amendment 24-A as a substitute for amendment 24. You are
2 now voting only on the substitution. A vote Aye is a
3 vote in favor of sub stituting 24-A for 24. A vote No
4 is a vote against the substitution.

5 Cast your votes. Has every delegate voted?
6 Does any delegate desire to change his vote?

7 The Clerk will record the vote.

8 There being 56 votes in the affirmative, and
9 61 in the negative, the motion fails, and amendment 24-A
10 is rejected.

11 The question now arises upon the adoption of
12 Amendment 24.

13 For what purpose does Delegate Storm arise?

14 DELEGATE STORM: Mr. Chairman, I ask unanimous
15 consent to suggest that amendment 24-B read as follows:

16 "All public records shall be open for inspection
17 unless otherwise provided by law, and to the extent and in
18 the manner provided by law. All governmental proceedings
19 and meetings shall be open to the public."

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Storm, I think it is
